Tournament Rules

2018 Montcalm/Ionia Area Futsal Invitational
June 16th & 17th



GENERAL RULES:

- * All players must present copies (please, no originals) of their birth certificates when they report prior to their first game. No exceptions. Players will receive a stamp when their age has been verified. They will need to be stamped before each game played in order to ensure ineligible players are not participating.
- * Goals cannot be scored directly from the kick-off.
- * When a team receives possession because the other team played the ball out of bounds, the ball is introduced back into play with a kick-in. There are no throw-ins. The ball is placed on or behind the boundary line and played into the court with the foot.
- * Goals cannot be scored from a kick-in from out of bounds.
- * There is no offside violation. Defenders beware.
- * Injury time, if deemed by the referee to be of a long enough duration, can add minutes to the half or game if it occurs in the second half. The referee will either time the additional minutes or ask the time keeper to add time.
- * The top three teams in each age group will receive a trophy. The fourth place team will receive a medal.
- * All players must sign a code of conduct as part of their registration. If they do not have a signed code of conduct they will not be allowed to play. No exceptions.

FLOOR SIZE:

The size for all preliminary game courts will vary by venue, but will be slightly smaller than a basketball court. This will enable us to get as many games in as possible at one time. We want to ensure that all teams play at least three games, so utilizing every inch of available space at each venue will be critical.

All Semi-final and Final games will be on courts that are larger, allowing more space to move, and creating opportunities for more of the creativity that is the signature of high quality futsal.

NUMBER OF PLAYERS:

U10-U12:

Four players with small goals. No goalkeepers. Each team can have two substitute players, for a total of 6 per team. Unlimited substitutions. Sub only during a natural stoppage of play. Each team must bring a futsal ball.

U14 and above:

Five players per team (four field players and a goal keeper). Each team can have two substitute players, for a total of 7 per team. Unlimited substitutions. Sub only during a natural stoppage of play. Each team must bring a futsal ball. Goal sizes may be slightly larger or smaller than official futsal regulation due to the size of the tournament and the number of venues involved.

GAME LENGTH:

U10-U12:

All games leading up to the championship game will consist of two 15 minute periods. Rolling clock. No time outs.

Championship games consist of two 18 minute periods. Each team gets one time out (1 minute). Clock stops during time out.

U14 and above:

All games leading up to the championship game will consist of two 20 minute periods. Rolling clock. No time outs.

Championship games consist of two 22 minute periods. Each team gets one time out (1 minute). Clock stops during time out.

UNIFORMS:

Teams must wear shirts/jerseys that closely match. They do not have to be identical, but must be close enough to show a clear association between team members.

No vulgar, racial, or profane images or words can be present on any part of the jersey.

If team jerseys for opposing teams are too close in color, the referee will designate one team to wear colored vests during the game.

DISCIPLINARY ISSUES:

This will be a family focused event. There will be young children present. Foul or offensive language will not be tolerated. **Yellow or red cards will be shown for the use of such language.**

In the event of a reckless challenge or any foul deemed excessive by the referee, a yellow card can be shown. If a player receives two yellow cards at any time during the tournament, a red card will result, and that player will be ineligible for the next game.

In the event that a foul or other infraction occurs that the referee feels warrants a red card, the player will be ejected from the game, and will also be ineligible for the next game.

If the infraction that brings a red card is of a nature that the referee feels is deserving of a more severe punishment, he/she can discuss the matter with the tournament officials, and the player in question may receive additional game bans, or may even be disqualified for the remainder of the tournament. If a player receives a red card and is disqualified for any number of games, their portion of the game fee will not be refunded for the games missed. The money is forfeit.

A substitute player may replace a sent-off player and enter the pitch **two full minutes after the sending-off**. They may, however, enter the pitch before the two minutes have elapsed should their team concede a goal while a player down.

Tournament Code of Conduct

Must be signed by both player and parent/legal guardian if player is under 18 years of age.
